

BCA Pool League Referee Program

Duties and Responsibilities

Effective May 2007

All BCAPL Referees:

- Know, uphold, apply and enforce the BCA Pool League's rules, regulations and policies.
- Comply at all times with the BCA Pool League's Referee Code of Conduct.
- Be reasonably available to local BCAPL organizations to promote understanding of the rules and the BCAPL Referee organization.
- Report to the Director of Referees any game situation they encounter that is not covered by the BCAPL Rules.
- Actively recruit others who show interest in the BCAPL Referee Program.

BCAPL Referees:

- Referee events at the local or state level.
- Participate in the continuing education program.
- * The BCAPL no longer offers this certification. However existing referees at this level may remain there until they are promoted.

BCAPL National Referees:

- Referee events at the local, state, regional or national level.
- Referee at the BCA National 8-Ball Championships, if asked and available.
- Upon request, observe referee trainees.
- Upon request, provide assistance to the Director of Referees.
- Participate in the continuing education program.

BCAPL National Senior Referees:

- Referee events at the local, state, regional or national level.
- Referee at the BCA National 8-Ball Championships unless otherwise excused.
- Observe referee trainees.
- Serve as a Shift Supervisor.
- Provide assistance to the Director of Referees.
- Upon request and if available, serve in an official capacity at other sanctioned events.
- Participate in the continuing education program.

BCAPL Head Referees:

- Appear at all National level events unless otherwise excused.
- Establish teams and work schedules at National events.
- Ensure adequate staff and floor coverage at National events.
- Provide written feedback to the Director following National events.
- Develop National recruitment strategies and procedures.
- Interview candidates considered for promotion.
- Make promotion recommendations to the Director of Referees.
- Upon request and as available, serve as chairpersons or committee members.
- Upon request and as available, serve in an official capacity at other sanctioned events.
- Advise the BCAPL's Administrative Authority concerning protests or unusual rules circumstances during any event.
